Preparing Data Files Defining Fields	FoD-OMR can apply date masking to data fields of up to 10 characters.

Masking Currency Custom Masking Printing Forms with merged Data	 Create a new variable text object or edit an existing variable text object. On the Link to field dialog box, select Date from the Mask as drop down menu. Select the original date type (date format in the data) from the Input format menu. Select the desired date type from the Output format menu. If you are using a DD/MM/YY format, select a date separator from the Short date separator menu. Underneath Year, check either the Two digit or Four digit year option. Click the OK button to apply the mask to the field. Note: It is important that the Input format chosen in FoD-OMR matches the format from the input data. If not, the output on the form shows an error message, such as "Invalid day: 2009", or shows the wrong date. Link to field is total_amount is an error message.
